**SPUC NATIONAL PRAYER CAMPAIGN: 10 MILLION PRAYERS FOR 10 MILLION LIVES LOST** On 27<sup>th</sup> October, it was exactly 55 years since the Abortion Act 1967 was passed. Since then, 10m babies have lost their lives in this country to abortion. The battle to defend life is above all a spiritual one and on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2022 SPUC launched a National Prayer Campaign in collaboration with the Knights of St Columba, to encourage more people to pray with renewed faith and trust for an end to the culture of death, and for a flourishing culture of life. The aim is to reach a milestone of 10m prayers being pledged between 27<sup>th</sup> October and 23 April 2023, in memory to the 10m lives lost to abortion.
