ST BEDE THE VENERABLE St Bede is depicted amongst the male saints, on the outer circle of the rose window above the High Altar. Known as "the Venerable Bede" for his combination of personal holiness and intellectual brilliance, he was born in Sunderland in 673, he was a Benedictine monk of Jarrow, biblical scholar and the first English historian. As a priest, he devoted his life to the study of scripture. He considered his 25 works of scripture commentary as his most important work., but many scholars regard his Ecclesiastical History of the English People, finished in 731, as his most significant. He died singing the 'Glory Be'. Boniface on hearing of his death, wrote that the 'candle of the Church, lit by the Holy Spirit, was extinguished.'
