PROPOSED PARISH TRIP EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST Please write your name/contact number on the sheet at the back of church if you are interested in a parish trip to Stonyhurst College over the summer holidays. The guided tour will include the museums, exhibitions and historic libraries; with highlights being a Shakespeare exhibition – a summer of Shakespeare, (including Shakespeare's first folio) 'Hot Holy Ladies' and an exhibition of relics. Many of the objects in the Museum bear witness to the Jesuits' unique place in English Catholic history and include vestments and embroidery. In addition, Prayer Books of Mary, Queen of Scots and Elizabeth of York can also be found. The three historic libraries contain books dating from 1471 including first editions of authors such as Charles Dickens, C.S. Lewis and Gerard Manley Hopkins. Also on view are notable paintings by artists such as Turner, Lely, Rembrandt and Rubens. For more info, google 'Stonyhurst Collections'.
