NOVENA TO THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION The Immaculate Conception is our belief that the Virgin Mary was free from original sin, by virtue of the merits of her son Jesus. Mary's sinless conception is the reason why Catholics refer to Mary as "full of grace". Since the Immaculate Conception is an important feast, it is custom in the Catholic Church to prepare for it nine days ahead of time. A Novena will be said from Wednesday 29th November after each Mass, until the Feast Day on 8th December. There are prayer sheets at the back of Church.
