DEANERY SYNOD UPDATE Our parish is part of the West Lancashire Deanery and parish priests and parish representatives from each parish in the Deanery are now established and meeting quarterly with the aim of supporting Parish Priests and enhancing the Catholic life of parishioners by working more closely together. In November, some members of the Deanery Synod also attended the Archdiocesan Synod in Liverpool and feedback from that is expected shortly. Within the Deanery itself, smaller clusters of parishes have been formed by the Archdiocese into families of parishes and our family of parishes encompasses St John the Evangelist Burscough, Our Lady and All Saints Parbold and St Joseph Wrightington. Local discussions are focusing on practical ways that local parishes can work.
