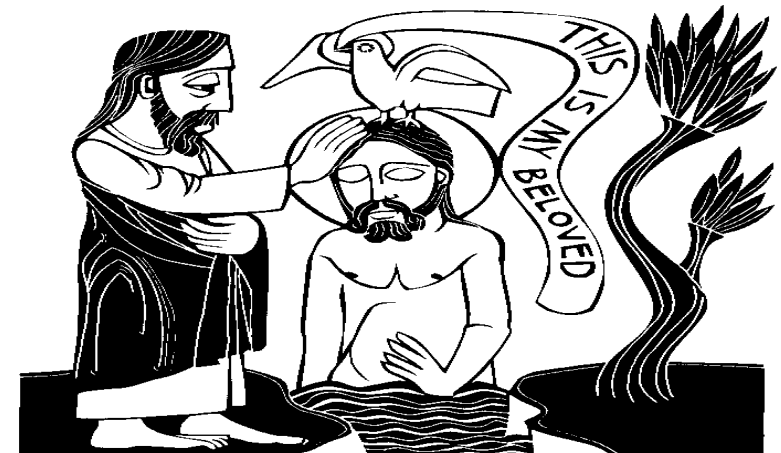

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

Saint Benet Biscop 12 January

Born in 628, he travelled extensively before founding and becoming the first Abbot of Wearmouth.

He ran his community based on the Rule of Saint Benedict and the seventeen Monasteries he had visited.

In 682, he founded the Monastery of Jarrow, which was dedicated to Saint Paul. Biscop collected an extensive library which assisted Saint Bede with his achievements.

Saint Kentigern 14 January

Monk and Bishop, there are many legends but few known facts about Kentigern.

Patron of Glasgow and secondary Patron of Liverpool. Until the 11th Century the Kingdom of Strathclyde incorporated Cumbria.

Until 1924 Cumbria was in the Archdiocese of Liverpool.

Saint Anthony of Egypt 17 January

Father of all Monks, he was born in Egypt about the year 250.

After the death of his parents, he gave all his worldly goods to the poor and went into the desert to live the life of penance.

He worked for the Church, gathering many followers. He died in 356.
