**Saints Sebastian and Fabian**  
**20 January**

Both suffered Martyrdom at the  
beginning of the persecution of Di-  
ocletian.

Fabian is buried in the Cemetery  
of Callistus and Sebastian in Ad  
Catacumbas on the Via Appaia.

## Saint Agnes

**21 January**

She suffered Martyrdom at Rome  
either in the second half of the  
third Century or the beginning  
of the fourth.

Pope Damasus embellished her  
tomb with sacred verses.

Many people, including  
Saint Ambrose spoke of her  
with great praise.
