SAINT OF THE WEEK

Saint Aelred

11 January

Saint Aelred of Rievaulx was a
Cistercian Abbot and writer.
He was born in 1110, educated at
Durham and joined the household
of St David I, King of Scotland.

He later became Abbot of Rie-
vaulx, near Ampleforth
and under his rule the number of
Monks increased to
150 Monks and 500 lay brothers.,
which was the largest of its time
in England.

He wrote a great many works
and died in January 1167 at Rie-
vaulx. He was never formally can-
onised, however the Cistercians set
his Feast Day in 1476.
