**SACRAMENTS**

The Certificates for Confirmation and Communion will be distributed at the Mass celebrating the conclusion of the *With you Always* programme, which will be held at School at **1030 Monday 29 June.**

**WEEKDAY MASS**

The number of Hosts for Communion, placed on the Paten at the Offertory, is calculated from those able to be seen by the Celebrant in the Retro Choir.

It is presumed that those in the main body of the Church—who sometimes cannot be seen, until too late—will not be going to Holy Communion.

Especially as some in the main body of the Church often leave before Communion.

**WEEKDAY SERVICES**

When a Priest is not available and there is no Deacon, Morning (or Midday or Evening) Prayer, the Liturgy of the Word and Holy Communion may continue to take place through those present.

No one person may "preside". One person should lead the Morning Prayer, one Person carry out the Readings and an Extraordinary Minister distribute Holy Communion.

There are laminated Cards in the Offertory Table in the Retro Choir to assist with this.

**SAINTS OF THE WEEK**

**Saint Barnabas**

**11 June**

Born in Cyprus, he was one of the first converts in Jerusalem and preached in Antioch. He became a companion of Saint Paul and went with him on his first missionary journey, where he took part in the Council of Jerusalem.

**Saint Anthony of Padua Priest and Doctor of the Church**

**13 June**

Born in Portugal at the end of the twelve century, Anthony became a Priest and Friar Minor, preaching the Gospel to great effect to the people of France and Italy, bringing many heretics back to the faith.

He became the first theologian of his Order and wrote a number of sermons which are renowned for their doctrine and gentleness.

**COMMUNION OF THE SICK**

*Priest:* Let us pray for our Sick as our Eucharistic Ministers are sent out to give them the Sacrament of Christ's Body.

**ALL:** May this Sacrament unite them with Christ and his Church and give them consolation and peace.

*Priest:* Ministers, in the name of the Church gathered here, take the Body of the Lord to the Sick of this Parish.
