FRANCE

As mentioned last weekend: in France the Diocese of Narbonne and Carcassone now has only 14 Mega Parishes.

A typical Parish has 82 Churches, served by only 2 priests. In the Diocese only 3 Churches have a Mass every Sunday, 54 Churches have mass every 3 months, the remaining 25 Churches have Mass once a year.

**SAINTS OF THE WEEK
SAINT MARY MAGDALENE**

22 July

One of Christ's Disciples and present at his death. On Easter Sunday Morning, she was the first to whom the risen Jesus appeared, according to Saint Mark's Gospel. Devotion to her spread throughout the western church especially in the twelfth century.

SAINT BRIDGET OF SWEEDEN

23 July

Saint Bridget was appointed one of the Patrons of Europe by Pope John Paul II. Born in Sweden in 1303, she married, becoming a mother to eight children. On her husband's death she founded the Bridgettine Order of Nuns, before moving to Rome where she died in 1373.

SAINT JAMES THE GREAT

25 July

Born at Bethsaida, the son of Zebedee and the brother of the Apostle John. He was present when Christ performed his most important miracles.

He was killed by King Herod about the year 42 and is venerated especially at Compostella in Spain where there is a magnificent Church dedicated in his honour.

COMMUNION OF THE SICK

Priest: Let us pray for our Sick as our Eucharistic Ministers are sent out to give them the Sacrament of Christ's Body.

ALL: May this Sacrament unite them with Christ and his Church and give them consolation and peace.
