SAINT LAURENCE 10 August

Laurence was a Deacon of the Church of Rome and died in the persecution of Valerian. He is buried at Campo Verano, near to where Constantine the Great built a basilica. He is the Patron of Ampleforth Abbey and all its works.

SAINT CLARE 11 August

Born at Assisi in the year 1193. She followed her fellow countryman Saint Francis into the life of poverty and was the founder and ruler of the Poor Clare's Nuns. She died in 1253.

SAINT MAXIMILLIAN KOLBE 14 August

A Polish Friar, he volunteered to die in place of a stranger in the Nazi concentration camp of Auschwitz in Poland in 1941. He was canonised by Pope John Paul II as Saint Maximilian in 1982
