

Re-opening of OLAS Church for Public Mass

Public celebration of weekday Mass resumed at Our Lady and All Saints on 13 July 2020, held at 7pm on a Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. This was following a health and safety inspection by the Dean of our Pastoral Area, Fr John Hindley and completed risk assessments approved by Ampleforth Abbey Trust, to minimise the health risk and ensure the safety of any person, Clergy and Lay using the Church.

We have the following in place:

- Volunteers to oversee the church at all times when it is open and make sure that social distancing is maintained.
- Volunteers to ensure sanitising takes place after all visits: this entails, wiping down of benches, tables and other handholds. All volunteers are provided with personal use rubber gloves, facemasks and cleaning materials and training.

Volunteers operate on a rota basis.
