FIRST HOLY COMMUNIONS

This year, these will take place during
Mass on **Sunday 27 June** and
Sunday 4 July, to accommodate both
First Holy Communicants for 2020 and
for 2021 from Our Lady and All Saints
parish.

We are not yet sure what the guidelines
will be on Corona virus restrictions
around this period, as we will wait for
notice from the Bishops' Conference.

However, it is likely that current
restrictions will remain in place at OLAS,
over these weekends.

Therefore, the First Communicants'
families will be restricted to one bench
per family, so we can also
accommodate parishioners.

Whilst, of-course, everyone is welcome
to attend Mass on those Sundays, if
there is still no Sunday obligation at
that time, you may wish to consider
attending Mass during the week instead.

Fr Daley will also be holding two First
Holy Communion ceremonies for St
John's parish on Sunday 23 May and
Sunday 13 June. He will still be
celebrating Mass at OLAS as usual at
10.30am on those dates.
